








Under a quarter of CCs are effectively online.




There's been no apparent change since 2012.





# But there has been massive churn




#### More bad news

- 11% have no contact mechanisms.
- Only 12% use social media.
- Only 13% have clearly visible planning sections.
- Lack of mobile support
- Issues around sustainability/ continuity

### A: Journalism!



#### **How is Leith Central CC doing?**

- ✓ Blog based website since 2009
  - ✓ regular news items
  - √ 'static' info
  - ✓ Automatically supports mobile
- ✓ Names and CC contact details
- ✓ Twitter account
  - ✓ auto-tweets new posts
  - ✓ Leah and Marion improving Twitter use
- ✓ Fits Journalist and Local Government archetypes
  - ✓ Does have campaigns? (Leith Walk?)
  - ✓ If so, should they have sections? How would these be managed?
- ✓ Planning section
- ✓ Continuity/sustainability (nearly) guaranteed

#### Other than online

- ✓ Tapping into new politically engaged young folk social media use?
- ✓ What is LCCC (and others) doing re Community Empowerment Act?
