Dear Harald and Sheila,

I thought it was only fair to keep you in the loop as LCCC formally supported the five bids I proposed to the Local Transport Improvement Plans (LTIs).

Unfortunately none of the five were successful will likely be successful this time, despite all scoring above the threshold of 15. Additionally the end-on parking request in the Abbeyhill Colonies from Cllr Arthur (I imagine through Cllr Dalgleish) and my proposal to refresh the markings in McDonald Road (NTBCC boundary) were also unsuccessful, as they were both deemed 'outwith the scope' of the LTI.

While I am disappointed, I will continue to pursue those five proposals with other teams outwith the LTI throughout the year, and due to LCCC's interest in submitting proposals in the future, am happy to assist LCCC members with any submissions in next year's round of funding. Additionally, I will continue pursuing other improvements such as dropkerbs at Sloan Street and Montgomery Street at Montgomery Street Lane, as well as many other proposals.

- Dalmeny Street / Easter Road junction | Score: 22 | Not approved | Monitor with AIP (Accident Incident Prevention) colleagues
- Ferry Road traffic island | Score: 20 | Not approved | Pedestrian crossing assessment to be carried out
- Easter Road pavement resurfacing | Score: 18 | Not approved | Consider this within 20-minute neighbourhood proposals
- Pilrig House Close | Score: 17 | Not approved | Consult with active travel on suitability. Path would require a redetermination order (RSO).
- Spey Street (east side) | Score: 16 | Not approved | Limited road space to widen and maintain controlled parking.
